Re: Updated Residential Move Processes

Due to the changes made to OHF Regulation 6 and Playing Regulation E55 regarding player transfers between OHF Member Partners, the NOHA has updated our process for the Residential Transfer of players between NOHA Associations and players transferring from outside of the OHF.

Players moving to the NOHA from another OHF Member Partner and vice-versa (Alliance, GTHL and OMHA) will be required to complete the “2023-2024 OHF Residential Move Transfer Form” and supply all the documents listed on the form to the OHF (transfers@ohf.on.ca). Once they receive approval from the OHF, the NOHA and the outgoing or incoming member will be notified and will transfer the player in the HCR.

Players moving within the NOHA from one MHA to another will be required to complete the “2023-2024 NOHA Residential Move Form” and supply two supporting documents showing their new address. These documents can be submitted to the players proposed new MHA or to myself at the NOHA Office (kmaitland@noha-hockey.ca).

Players moving from outside of the OHF to the NOHA (from other provinces or from Hockey Eastern Ontario and Hockey Northwestern Ontario) will follow the same process as players moving within the NOHA.

Though all players now have to option to participate with the MHA of their choosing, their current Residential Address must be listed on their HCR profile. Registrars are to ensure that this information is accurate when submitting rosters for approval, and notify families when they need to submit paperwork to update their address (paperwork is not required if the player is only moving within the boundaries of their current primary association).

If you have any questions about the updated Residential Move process, or are unsure which process a player should follow, please let me know.
